St Helens & Districts CAMRA Real Ale Maps

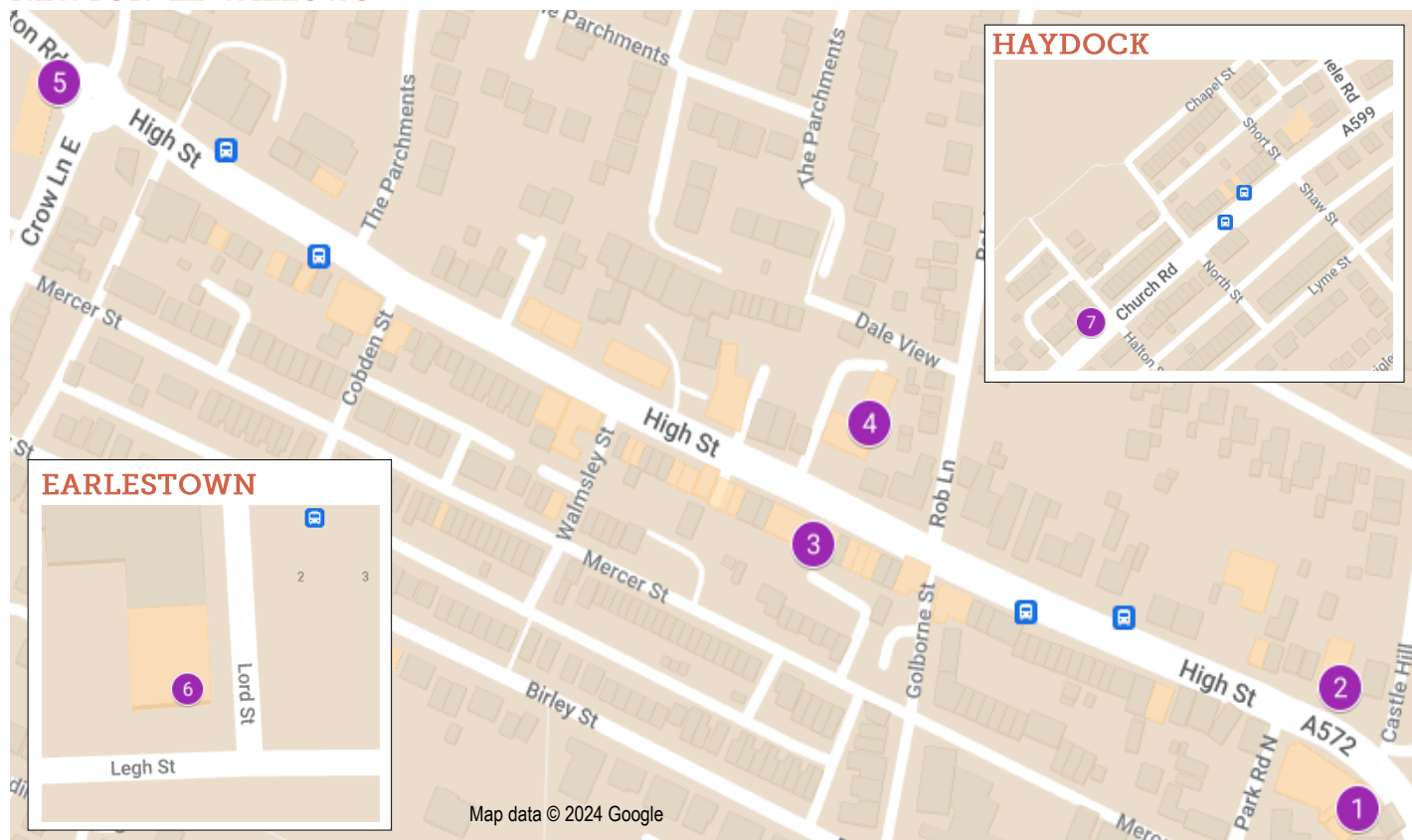


***Newton-le-Willows,

Campaigning for Pubs, Pints & People

1 The Kirkfield 5

The Kirkfield offers quality food and a good choice of real ales served in the separate bar, normally with at least one dark beer. Sports TV in the bar area. Beer garden to the rear.

2 Stocks Tavern 2

Traditional pub with a renovated interior. Real ale is normally from Bank Top brewery. Beer garden to the rear. Sports TV.

3 The Firkin 8

Small friendly pub. Real ale normally includes at least one dark beer and there is as a range of craft beers. Regular tap takeovers from smaller independent breweries.

4 The Pied Bull 4

Large and popular pub in the centre of the high street. Beers sourced nationally. Beer garden to the rear and patio area to the front. Sports TV.

5 The Oak Tree 2

Traditional pub comprising one large bar area with adjoining separate rooms. Beer garden to the rear. Sports TV

6 The Nine Arches 6

A large Weatherspoon's pub. The building was originally a chapel and has been restored using wooden beams in the roof and keeping bare brickwork on show throughout. Real fire. Beer garden.

7 Haydock Reading Room 3

Since 1884 The Haydock Reading Room has provided a warm and welcoming place for all who like a drink with good company. The club allows CAMRA members in as guests on showing a valid CAMRA card. Sports TV. Live music and other events for the community often take place over the weekend.
